ADCs by their nature aim at finding the most **sustainable**, **beautiful + inclusive design** solutions while attracting a large number of designs raising the chance to get the most efficient and innovative solution. There is a close relation between ADCs and the New European Bauhaus:

Doing ADCs across borders makes it possible to also reach architects from different perspectives and design backgrounds,

The accessibility of competitions across the border is still not so common.


